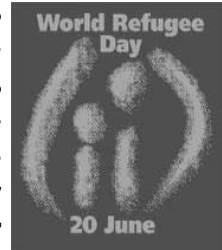

They come mainly from Sudan and Myanmar (Burma) and have fled their homelands because of discrimination and hostility. These brave men, women, and children are struggling to build a new life in an unfamiliar culture.



The Episcopal Refugee Network of San Diego serves over 100 families each month and relies heavily on support from churches.
