The Men of St. John's at St. John's in Chula Vista have set a challenge to match over 700 jars of peanut butter with matching jelly for the Homeless/Marginal Person's dinner program on Wednesday evenings. The dinners are put together by a number of community organizations and churches and have been quite successful. St. John's has participated in this program for a number of years. A loaf of bread is given to the homeless and needy after dinner and with the unbelievable collection of peanut butter we have been challenged to donate jars of jelly. With this great generosity, people are able to have the food they need. Each week South Bay Community Services hands out food to those in need every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. St. John's member Rene Malle has provided leadership to this ministry in the quarterly feeding. Every quarter other ministries come together and serve a warm meal to the homeless.

The Men of St. John's current campaign goal is to collect 700 jars of jelly. To keep this drive a success, all donations of jelly (plastic jars if available) are greatly appreciated. 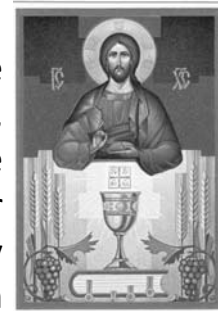
